Game 3: North County (H) vs. Seaside (V), Lower field, 12 noon

Game 4: Toro (H) vs. Marina Red (V), Upper field, 1 pm

Game 5: Seaside (H) vs. Marina Black (V), Lower field, 3 pm

Game 6: Toro (H) vs. North County (V), Lower field, 9 am

Game 7: Marina Red (H) vs. Seaside (V), Upper field, 10 am

RULES:

- A). Except as noted below, the official playing rules shall be the 2009 Pony Baseball rules and regulations for pintos:
- B). Ten players may be used defensively. The four outfielders must be positioned at least 15 feet behind the baselines.
- C). All players on the team roster should have played defensively in at least 1 inning by the end of the 4th inning.
- D). Game length is 5 innings or 1 hour 45 minutes, which ever comes first. No extra innings (the game can end tied).
- E). No new inning will begin after 1 hour 44 minutes. If an inning has been started before the time limit elapses, then the entire inning is to be completed.
- F). Free substitutions allowed for any defensive position except pitcher. Once a pitcher is replaced he/she cannot return to pitch again in the same game
- G). All members of the team will bat in an assigned batting order regardless of whether he/she is actively playing in the field (continuous batting order).
- H). 5-run rule for first 3 innings 10 run mercy rule after the fourth.
- I). No bunting or soft swinging. PENALTY: The pitch is a strike and the ball is dead. No dropped 3rd strike. No infield fly rule.
- J). The players will pitch to each other, and balls and strikes will be called by an umpire.
- K). Pitchers can pitch a total of 3 innings per day, no exceptions. One pitch thrown by a pitcher constitutes an inning.
- L.) Runners cannot lead off bases. Runners shall remain in contact with the base until the ball is hit or crosses home plate. PENALTY: If a runner is off the base and the ball is hit, the runner is out and the ball is in play.
- M). Runners can steal 2nd and 3rd base after the ball crosses home plate. Runners may not steal home. PENALTY: If a runner or runners leave early, the lead runner who left early is out, any other runners that advanced return to their previous base, and the ball is dead.
- N). Runners may advance 1 base on an overthrow. Runners MAY NOT advance home on an overthrow.
